At City Living NY, our mission is to empower youth aging out of foster care to transition successfully into adulthood by providing essential resources and in-depth support.

Why Your Support Matters

When most young adults turn 21, they're still figuring things out, usually with support from family, a couch to crash on, and someone to call when things go wrong. For youth aging out of foster care, that safety net disappears overnight.

Each year, hundreds of young people in New York City age out of foster care, often with no family to lean on and no resources to build a stable life. Many move into their first apartments with nothing but a bag of clothes. We meet them at the door with dignity and support: dishes, bedding, a table and chairs, even a shower curtain. Essentials most of us take for granted—but for them, it's the beginning of a home.

The results speak for themselves:

- While 1 in 4 former foster youth in NYC become homeless, **CLNY** has a 100% success rate in preventing eviction.
- Nationally, only 3% of former foster youth graduate college, at CLNY 68% of our youth with an education goal, are currently enrolled, with 97% of those on track to graduate.
- While 10% of all newborns are reported to child protective services by age 3, that number rises to 54% for children of mothers who experienced foster care. At CLNY, 26% of our clients are young parents, and while 4 currently have open cases, we stand by them every step of the way to ensure they keep custody of their children.

To date City Living NY has served **437 youth and counting**. We don't just help youth survive —we help them build a future filled with stability, independence, and hope.
